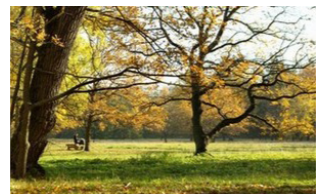


# Feng shui est... (Kadriorg park)

**Wood** - existing oak trees. Preserving maximum of existing, to create Feng shui garden.



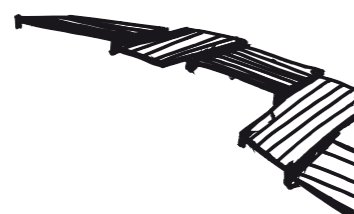
**Fire** - people with their emotions. Recreation, meditation, tea ceremony, observing surroundings.

**Metal** - using white color. Wall with openings – to frame the view. Seclusion – pavilion. The base form of a pavilion and a wall opening is form of Bagua.

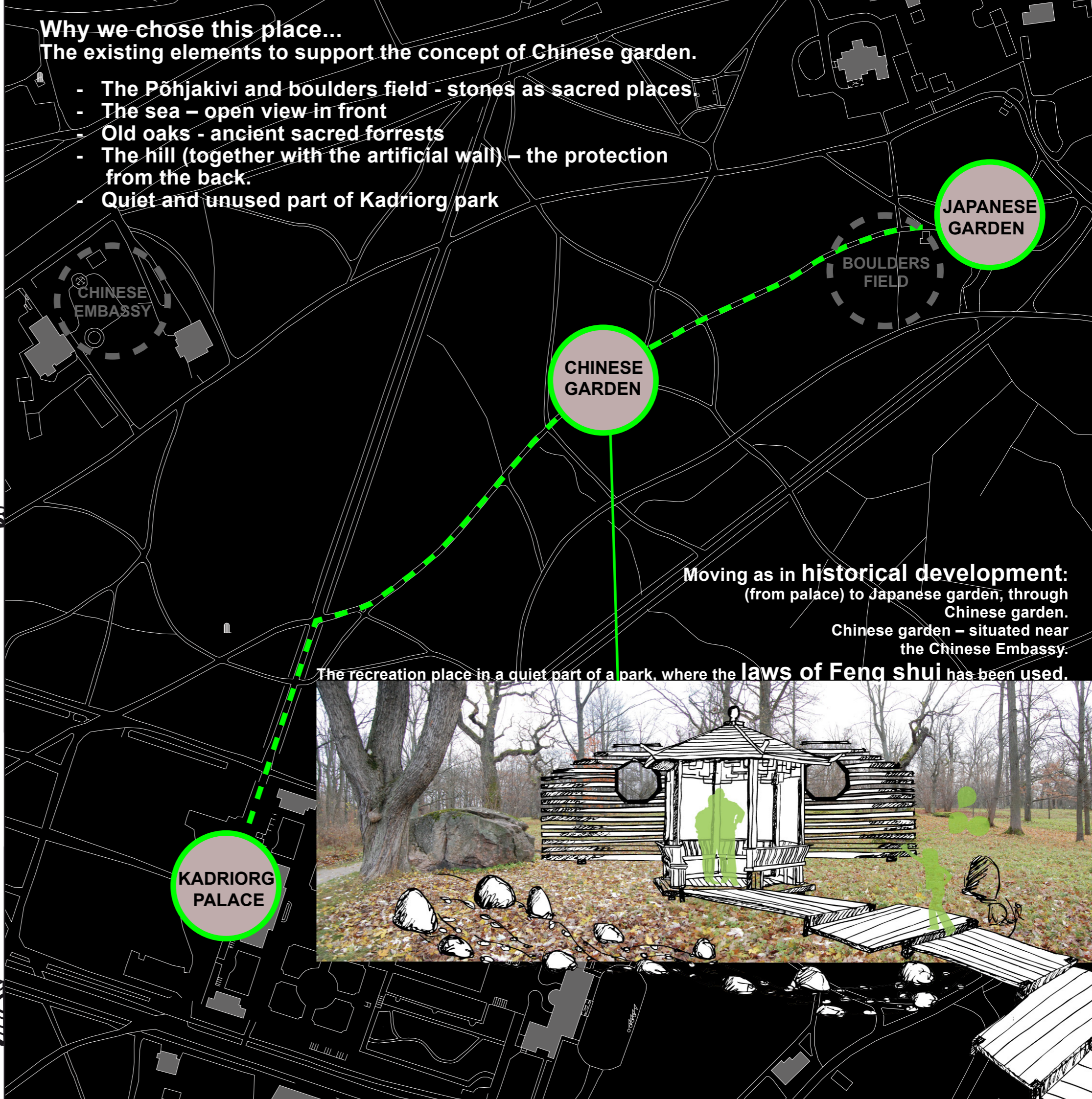


**Water** - The correct flow of life energy - zigzag bridge and the open view to the sea
