



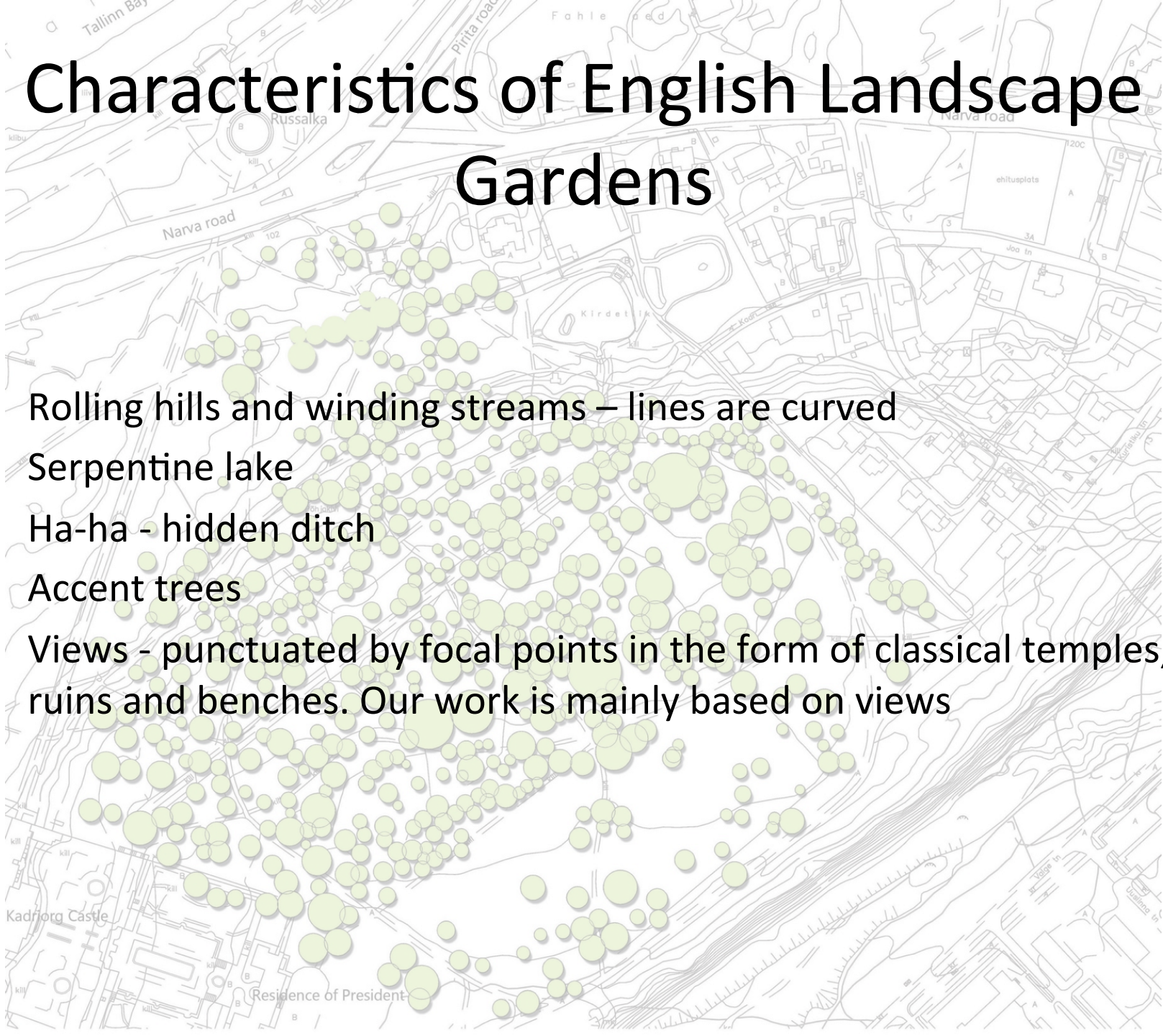

8. Almost no views to the sea, only in some places and very narrow

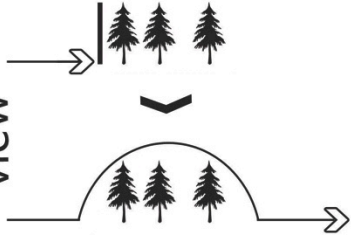

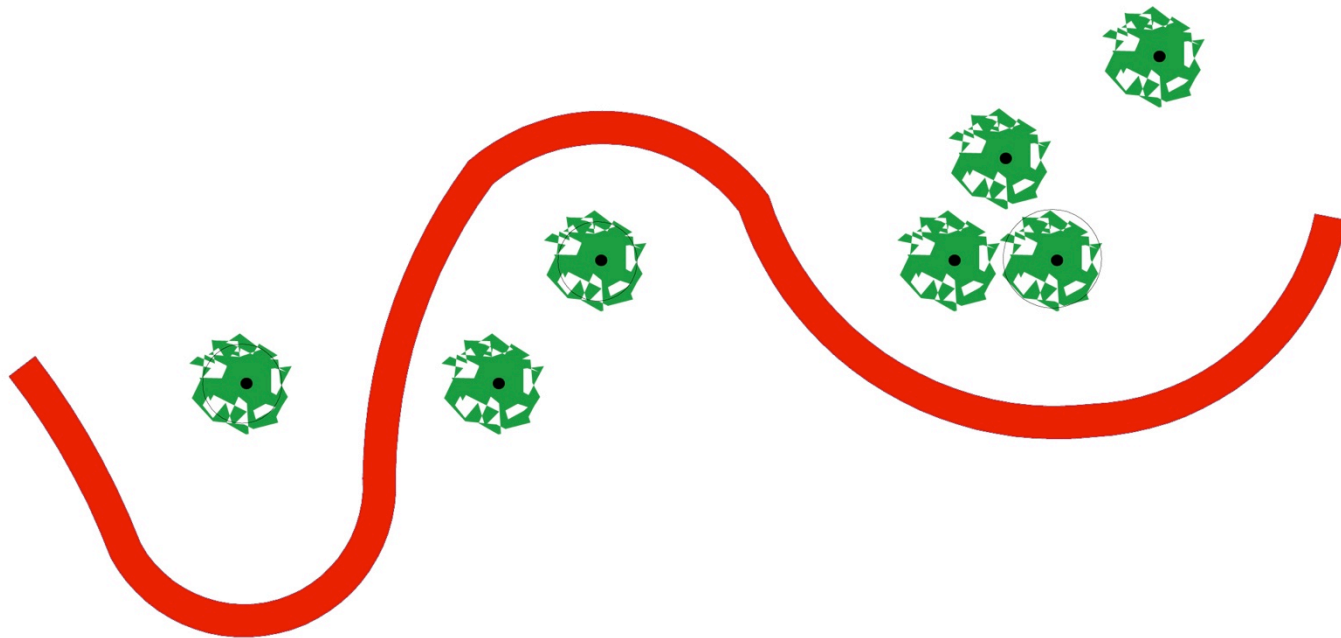
